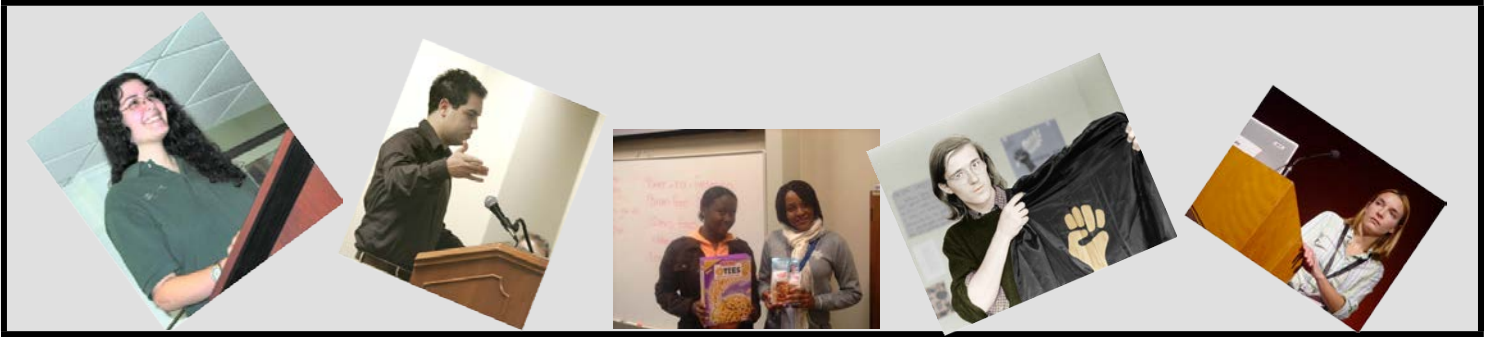

The text body of the message should contain your name, affiliation, and paper title. The proposal should be an attached file (word or pdf), and it **must not** include your name and/or affiliation.
